Jayne was gracious enough to follow me through some thirteen transfers with my company, including MA, CT, NH, VT and NJ with nary a complaint.

I'll never forget when we were building a house in NH (the builder lived nearby} and we visited there each Sunday to see the progress, when Jayne said "that house is too close to the road". I could not see that as it was still a dirt road so hard to tell where it was. So, after thinking about it I called the builder. He said "you stay in the finance business and I will stay I the building trade". Apparently he thought about it and called me back "agreeing" and he subsequently had to knock down the foundation.

On another move Jayne told the movers the truck was not large enough. They soon found out it was so and ordered another truck.
