Margarete Käthe Klassa, 71, passed away at PruittHealth Raleigh on May 2, 2019.

A funeral service will be held on Thursday, May 9th at the chapel at Wake Memorial Park in Cary, NC at 2pm, officiated by Deacon Rich Mickle of St. Andrews Catholic Church.

Margaret (as she was known to friends and family) was born on October 2, 1947, in Fulda, Germany, to Adam and Sofie Dehler. She studied to be a pharmacy technician in her native Germany. After meeting the love of her life, Harold, she spent the next decades of her life raising a family, volunteering on military bases and in schools, and generally loving everyone she met.
