Stanley R. Stober, 73, of Southport, North Carolina and formerly of Gales Ferry, Connecticut, died on September 27, 2018. After a courageous battle with cancer, he died peacefully surrounded by his family.

Stan was the beloved husband of Mary (Orkney) Stober for 52 years. Stan and Mary were blessed with a large and loving family. In addition to his wife, Stan is survived by his children Matthew (Michelle), Andrew (Marnie) and Gretchen (Dennis) Moen; as well as his grandchildren David Foster, Alex Beilinson, Nicole Stober, Matthew Stober Jr., Callie Stober, Luke Stober, Bridget Stober and Collin Moen; and his great grandchildren Gavin, Harper and Levi Foster.
