Betty Hackney Griffin, 86, passed away peacefully on August 24, 2025.

A woman of steadfast faith, Betty was a devoted member of her church and found her greatest joy in worship and fellowship. Sundays were her favorite day of the week—spent in the Lord's house and surrounded by family and friends.

Betty's life was a beautiful reflection of love, kindness, and devotion. She will be deeply
