Brett Michael Staponkus, 38, passed away unexpectedly on August 3rd.

He was SO worried about me travelling alone, but he was ALWAYS SO PROUD of all of the decisions I made in life- he was so supportive and caring. I then moved to Golden, CO, and shortly after he followed. He instantly made friends- everybody just always loves him at first impression. I have several friends out here that are heartbroken to hear of his passing. He was a real animal lover and I was there when he adopted his dog, Lily. He asked me to come with to the foster home because he respected my opinion on if she would be a good fit- he didn't need me there, it was love at first sight. He was a big worrier when it came to being a dad to Lily. As I look through my phone it is pretty often where he is asking me advice for something about her. I am so grateful that the last 6 months or so we have been on a group text with our best friends (Brett Cummings & Matt Jelonek). We texted almost every day, and would have group phonecalls...Our conversations are all very goofy and fun. I can't begin to write all the memories... I can see his face and his smile all day long. I have items around my home that will forever remind me of him, gifts he gave to me...like the seashells he always brought to me from his vacations. He was a caring, loving, generous, kind soul that always made me laugh. We never ended a conversation without telling eachother we loved eachother. 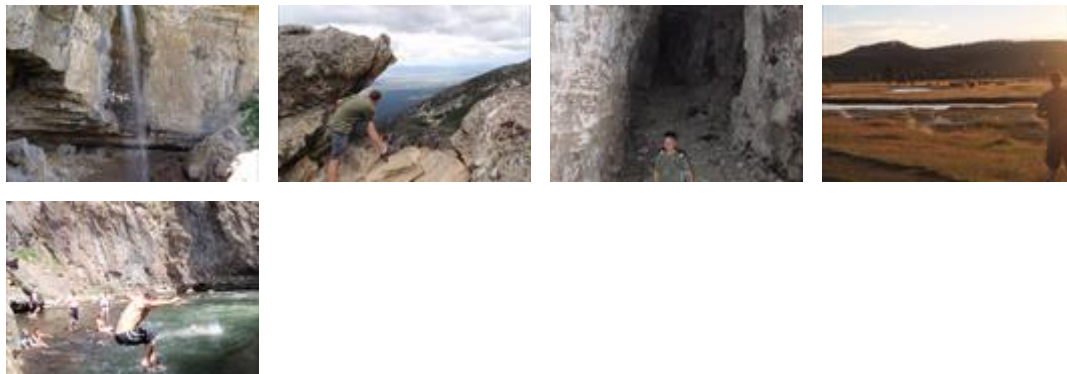
