



Charles Oellig Keagy III

Charles Oellig Keagy III, affectionately known as Chuck, passed away peacefully at his home in Cary, North Carolina, on March 8, 2025, at the age of 79.

Chuck is survived by his wife, Diane; and his sons, Charles, IV of Raleigh, James and wife Leslie of Apex, and his grandchildren, Mason, Lawson, and Abigail. He is also survived by his brother, Alan and wife Cindy, their four sons, as well as his brother, Craig, of Virginia Beach.

Born in Portsmouth, Virginia, on November 5, 1945, Chuck was the son of Charles, Jr. and Betty Keagy. Due to his father's career in the U.S. Army, Chuck's childhood was marked by travel, living in several places, including Japan and Panama, before his family settled in Virginia.
