David Charles Franke, of Cary, NC, died on April 28, 2016. He was the son of Barbara and George Franke, of Loveland, CO, and the brother of Heidi Fritz (Carl) of Denver, CO. David was born in Harrisburg, PA on June 12, 1968. For most of his younger years he lived and went to school in Waukegan, IL, where he met his first wife Tracie Stojak. David and Tracie both had a love for dogs and did dog rescue for a number of years, in Illinois, Wisconsin, and Spokane, WA. It was in Spokane that David later met his second wife, Joan Snover, with whom he moved to North Carolina.

David was blessed with musical and artistic talents, as well as an aptitude for hands-on technical and mechanical work. Most of his working career was spent in the field of Heating, Ventilation, and Air-Conditioning (HVAC) for several different companies. David enjoyed hunting and being in the outdoors. He also had an affinity for cooking which brought him pleasure.

David is sadly missed by his parents, sister, and his dog Ziva as well as other family members and many friends, especially in and around Waukegan, IL. He also had many close friends from other locations that he had met through the American Multiple Endocrine Neoplasia Support Facebook Group (AMEN Support), which was a help to him for a number of years after he was diagnosed with the rare MEN1 disease in 2009.

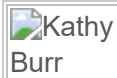

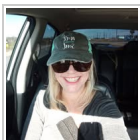
