Edward John Mariner, 90, of Morrisville, NC, died peacefully in his sleep on February 8, 2022 at UNC Hospital, Chapel Hill. He was born January 2, 1932 in Bronx, New York, the son of Peter and Edith (Wayburn) Mariner.

Ed graduated from Evander Childs High School in the Bronx in 1949. He served in the US Navy from 1952 - 1954. After his service, he married his high school sweetheart, Marlene Kreiss, and they resided in the Bronx until 1959 after which they moved to Yonkers, New York where they raised their children. They celebrated 67 years of marriage as of May 15, 2021.

He is survived by his wife, Marlene, of Morrisville, NC as well as his son Thomas (Donna) of Cary, NC and his daughter Susan (Chris Calabro) of Cincinnati, OH.
