Elsamma was born on September 9, 1952, as the second daughter of Mathai and Aleykutti Padinjare Varikat in a small village called Cherpunkal in Kerala, India. She has 6 brothers and 2 sisters.

Elsamma completed high school education from St. Mary's High School Kidangoor and pursued a career in education, which was her passion. She taught children for a few years. Later, she started her own preschool and enjoyed being part of their development in the early years of life.

She continued her teaching profession until her marriage with S.D. Abraham in

1978. Mr. Abraham was a serviceman in the Indian Army and within a few years, the couple was blessed with two children, Justin and Juliet. She then focused her energy and experience as a teacher towards her children and raised them to be successful young adults.

Elsamma departed us at the age of 72. When we look back at her life, it wasn't

always a smooth journey for her. Many times, life challenged her with hard realities, sometimes she struggled, and sometimes nearly failed. However, she

fought back each time and brought her life on track. After her husband passed away in 2016, the biggest challenge she ever faced, her health started to decline.

A life to remember, a life to cherish, and a life that touched many, that is the legacy that was left behind by Elsamma. Now we leave her, to her journey to the resting place of her husband. May we pray that this journey be to a place without pain. We will keep her alive in our lives by cherishing her memories.
