Eric Vincent Mayer, 62, died October 1, 2023. He was born March 14, 1961 in Vicenza, Italy, the son of Anton and Joan Mayer.

Eric graduated from the The United States Military Academy at West Point, class of 1983. Following graduation Eric served in the 82nd Airborne Division of the Army and was honorably discharged as a Captain. Eric went on to receive a master's degree in business from Lehigh University, at which time his 25+ year career in Industrial Automation began.

Eric was an active member of St. Andrew Catholic Church dedicating his time as a lector. Eric was of service to his fellow man always practicing compassion and generosity towards others.

Eric is survived by his loving wife, Nancy of 39 years and his 3 devoted children, Ian (Robyn) Mayer, Stephanie (Chase) Yandle, and Alexander Mayer; his 4 grandchildren, Maggie, Cole, Olivia, and Cade; his sister Tina (Bill) Gillis.
