Fredrick Eugene DePorter, 78, of Holly Springs, NC passed away on August 4, 2022 at Transitions Lifecare Raleigh, NC. He was born on January 7, 1944 in Philadelphia, PA to Walter and Ann DeMara DePorter.

Gene is survived by his loving wife of 44 years, Georgette Farley DePorter, daughter Megan A. Zeishner (Harold Zeishner) of Apex, NC, sons Michael F. DePorter of Wilmington, NC and Drew D.
