Gregory Joseph Brannon, a Son of God, beloved husband and father to seven children, 64, of Cary, North Carolina passed away in his home on July 27, 2025 leaving behind many grieving hearts.

I will never forget you coming into the exam room with bright colored running shoes on and workout clothes. You seldom wore a white coat in the office, which I think you knew brought a sense of peace to us patients. Some people thought you lacked bedside manners, but I can testify to how well you loved your patients.

In July 2012, while Devon and I awaited the arrival of our first child, you came in (like a bolt of lightning ⚡) and told me that I may need a cesarean if things didn't start progressing. I was terrified and wasn't sure I was ready for that. You told me that you would sit outside of my hospital room all night with a book if I wanted you to. Waiting patiently for whenever I was ready, or whenever it was necessary to do it regardless of my timeframe.

Another baby came in 2014 and again in 2017 and 2019. During my delivery with Scarlett in 2017, some complications arose and I became very sick. For the first time ever, I saw true concern on your face. After an ovary and fallopian tube removal during delivery and everything that happened afterwards, you were there making sure I made it out of there the healthiest version of myself. I thought we were done seeing you after that, Doc. But God!

18 months later, you delivered our final child. I was so happy to have you deliver our last one, right before you started thinking about retirement from obstetrics. ❤️

Devon and I had the pleasure of hosting you and Jody in our home for dinner, which made us even more fond of the human being you were. We were privileged to call you our doctor and our friend.

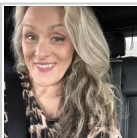

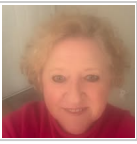

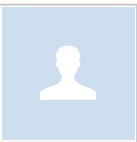
