



Hunter Coleman Murray Jr.

January 1, 1951 - April 28, 2023

It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Hunter Coleman Murray, aged 72, of Apex, North Carolina. Hunter passed away peacefully on April 28, 2023, at his residence in Apex, surrounded by his loving family. Hunter was born on January 1, 1951, in Jacksonville, North Carolina to Hunter and Alice Murray.

After graduating from high school, Hunter entered the US Army and served in Korea. He continued his military service in the NC National Guard following his honorable discharge. He also worked tirelessly to continue his education, one course at a time, until he graduated from North Carolina Wesleyan University. Later he earned a Masters degree from Strayer University. Hunter worked in the telecommunications field with various companies over the years, finally retiring from Qualcomm in 2016.

Hunter's free time activities included music and art. He played Irish traditional music with various groups over the years and also enjoyed performing with his son Michael, daughter-in-law Klara and friend Mark Liberto at senior living centers in the most recent years. A love of watercolor painting also kept him busy and creative.

Hunter is survived by his wife of 43 years, Barbara Elizabeth Robinson. He is also survived by his son David Hunter Murray and his wife Marta Kasterka Murray of Dundee, Scotland, and his son Michael Patrick Murray and his wife Klara Shirley Murray of Apex, North Carolina. One of the greatest joys of his life was spending time with his family, and he loved his grandchildren Lilia, Adela, Cole, Luke, and Dale immensely.

Hunter is also survived by his brothers Rufus, Hoover, William, and Frank and his sisters Bonnie, Jewell, Joy and Mary, plus many nieces and nephews.

Hunter was kind, generous, a friend to all, and an incredible father and loving husband. He loved the Lord and rejoiced in each day he was given. He will be greatly missed.
