While in North Carolina, she became a Medicare/Medicaid counselor, consulted on tax returns for low-income people, worked at the Saint Dorcas Food Pantry and helped establish the library at The Templeton of Cary, the senior living community where she resided.

Our family had a wonderful 90th birthday dinner for her this past December which was attended by her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. She was ecstatic and was absolutely beaming with maternal pride as she surveyed the gathering.
