December 10, 1928 - October 6, 2023

John Frank Rapp, age 94, from Raleigh, NC, died peacefully at home, in the care of his family, on October 6, 2023. He was born on December 10, 1928, in Buffalo, NY, where he lived before moving to North Carolina in 1997. John was a hard worker, but he also had a generous, playful spirit. He had a good sense of humor; his philosophy in life was that if something wasn't exactly right, it could always be improved with a little ketchup. He enjoyed playing the piano and accordion. As a young man, John played in a band. Later in life, he and his best friend Ido would play boogie-woogie music at retirement homes. Some people would get up from their wheelchairs and dance; others would wake up

and smile.

John Frank was a light to many. He valued home, family, and faith, rising every morning at 4:30 to pray. His home was the gathering place for birthday and holiday celebrations, Masses, and memorial services. All of us witnessed the love he had for us, for his God, and for his late wife, Barbara. In his words, “marrying that gal” was the best decision he ever made. We will miss him but are glad that he is reunited at last with his lovely Barbara and with all family members who left this world before him.

Visitation and Wake Service will be held on Thursday, October 12, 2023, between 9:00-10:00 a.m., at St. Mary, Mother of the Church, in Garner, NC. A funeral Mass will follow at St. Mary at 10:00 a.m. The inurnment will take place at St. Andrew the Apostle Roman Catholic Church in Apex, NC, immediately following the funeral.
