When discharged from the Army, he went to work for the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, first as a bus driver, then as a train operator, and finally as a manager. He retired in 1995. Johnny lived his life to the fullest. He enjoyed fishing and hunting with his brother George, playing golf, and, of course, weightlifting. He was very competitive, always striving to be one step ahead of the competition. His fervor for life was visible for all to see as he celebrated all that the Lord had blessed him with; his wife, his children, and his grandchildren. He was proud of them all. He traveled extensively, locally and abroad. Life was indeed a pleasure and a big adventure to Johnny.

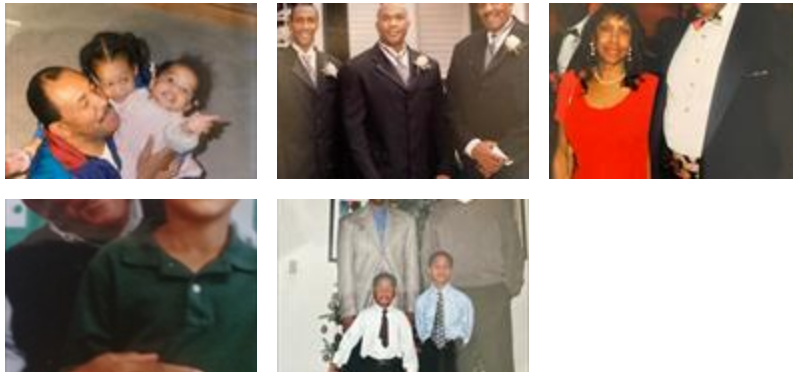
