



Joseph Ching-chi Cheng

June 1, 1938 - April 28, 2023

Joseph Ching-chi Cheng died peacefully on April 27, 2023, of end-stage renal disease in Cary, North Carolina. He was the beloved husband of Esther Cheng and loving father to Wendy, Patty, and Judy Cheng. He is also survived by his grandchildren Abigail and Eileen Stauffer and Alexander and Anderson Chen.

Joseph was born on June 1, 1938, in Hsinchu, Taiwan. He attended Hsinchu High School and National Taiwan Normal University, eventually earning a bachelor's degree in social science education. He went on to receive his masters in library science from Clark Atlanta University and worked for many years as a library cataloger at North Carolina Central University (NCCU) in Durham, North Carolina.

In high school and college Joseph was a member of the track team and won awards in the 500- and 1000-meter track events at both the high school and collegiate levels. After he became a cataloger at NCCU, he also enjoyed lending a helping hand to new Chinese students arriving from overseas to study at local universities as well as organizing Bible study for local Chinese small groups. He enjoyed watching sports events such as the Olympics and watching his grandchildren grow.
