Judith Kay Dunphy (nee Mitchell) was born on January 12, 1939 to Claude Willis Mitchell and Grace (nee Grabovac) in Springfield, Illinois. She graduated in 1962 with a BS from the University of Illinois in Urbana, Champaign.

Judy Kay married Edward James Dunphy on August 18, 1962. They moved to Raleigh in 1975 and raised three sons, Kevin, Brian, and Cory.

Judy worked in Administration at Athens Drive High School where she volunteered at the library after she retired. She was also recognized as an honorary marching band member at the school.

Judy is survived by her husband, two of her sons, three daughters-in-law, eight grandchildren, a great grandchild, and her sister, Eleanor. Her brothers, Dee and Jim predeceased her as did her son, Kevin.

On Wednesday, October 18, visitation will start at 10 am at St. Andrew the Apostle Roman Catholic Church, with the Funeral Mass starting at 11:30 AM.
