Judith Aileen Palmisano-Raparelli (née Silletti), 79, of Raleigh, North Carolina passed away in the early morning of Christmas Eve, December 24, 2022. Judi (with an 'i') was born in Jersey City, New Jersey to Ralph and Frances Silletti. She grew up in Ridgefield. She is survived by her younger sister, Linda, and brother-in-law, Frank Sepulveres, of Midland Park, New Jersey. After Carl's passing, she moved to Raleigh, North Carolina to be closer to her daughter, Dina,

along with her husband David Wolstromer and six grandchildren: Bryan, Emily, Jillian, Heather,

Lita and Lex. She loved nothing more than spending time with her family, especially around the holidays.

She was always thinking of her friends and family and kept track of every important (and not so important) event in their lives. Every year, she would rewrite it all on her new calendar, usually

a personalized calendar created by her son-in-law. And if she found something in a newspaper

or magazine that she thought may interest someone she loved, she would cut it out. Whenever

you saw her, she had dozens...and dozens...of stories for you. She was friendly with everyone

she met, some would say "too friendly" with her doctors in her later single years. But she

always left everyone with a smile.
