June 28, 1922 - December 19, 2022

On Monday, December 19, 2022, Lucille Stone died at the age of 100. Lucille was born to Julius “Jack” and Ida Daniels on June 28, 1922. After graduating from high school at the age of 15, she attended Brooklyn College in New York. She then went to work for Graysons of California as a buyer in New York. In August 1942 she married Seymour who left shortly after for Europe and WWII. Following WWII, she and Seymour moved to Washington, D.C., where she worked for Bell Telephone before moving on to Chrysler Corporation where she became the first female to reach management level in Chrysler Corporation. She and Seymour raised two sons, Ira and George. Upon retiring she and Seymour moved to Orlando, Florida, where she continued to work as a real estate agent. They then moved to Jacksonville, Florida, for a brief period before moving to Yorktown Heights in New York. This was followed by a move to Ocala, Florida, and after Seymour died, she moved back to Yorktown Heights where she lived before moving to the Raleigh, North Carolina, area. Lucille was an avid Mah Jongg player, and she enjoyed using her computer for email and to keep abreast of world events. She has said that she accomplished everything she wanted to do in life, and that she had no regrets. Lucille is preceded in death by her husband Seymour, her father Julius, her mother Ida, and her sister Pearl. She is survived by two sons, Ira and George, along with 13 grandchildren, and 12 great-grandchildren.
