Marta “Sissy” Noelia Cruz, 65, of Cary, North Carolina, passed away on Sunday November 13, 2022, at Rex Hospital in Raleigh, NC.

Ms. Cruz was born on June 23, 1957, in Ft. Knox, Kentucky, the daughter of CSM Sigifredo Cruz-Vega and Martha Magdalena Galonska. She was the second of seven children, a loving, giving and caring daughter, sister, wife and friend.
