Doctor Martin Thomas Lowy passed away suddenly on March 1, 2025. He was born to the late Dr. Howard and Phyllis Lowy of East Peoria, Illinois on September 29th, 1954. He graduated from Spalding High School in Peoria in 1972. He continued his studies at Marquette University for his undergraduate degree and completed his PhD degree at Purdue University in Pharmacology/Toxicology in 1982. He completed a 3 year postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Chicago Pritzker Medical School from 1982-1985.

His long career began in academia at Case Western Reserve University and later many years in drug development at GSK. His work with GSK saw him travel abroad with many trips to Italy and the United Kingdom. The area of neuroscience was always his career focus and passion. In his retirement, he was involved as a consultant for a startup and enjoyed staying active in that project.
