Norman Edward Lloyd, 94, of Raleigh NC, passed away on February 14, 2024.

Dad was born on February 20, 1929 to parents Pauline Harris Lloyd and Joseph Ross Lloyd in Oak Park IL. He earned his bachelor's degree at Rockhurst College (1952), his master's at Kansas State (1953), and his doctorate at Purdue University (1956). He had a productive career in biochemical research, culminating as Vice President of Research for Nabisco Brands. His proudest career achievement the invention of a process for extracting and concentrating fructose from corn sugars.

Dad always described the day he met Mary Charlene Young as the day he was "thunderstruck" – that very day he told his parents he'd met the woman he would marry. Ed and Charlene married on November 22, 1951, and their loving union lasted for nearly 60 years. Ed is survived by his eight children, Susan Long (James), Sally Lloyd, John Lloyd (Janis), Charles Lloyd (Amelia DeLoach), Daniel Lloyd, Denise Stetter (Irvin), Amy Fergione (David), and Mark Lloyd; 20 grandchildren, and 16 great grandchildren. Dad missed our mother so very much after she passed away in 2010 that we believe his passing on Valentine's Day reflected his deep yearning to be reunited with his life-long sweetheart.

Services for Norman Edward Lloyd will be held on February 23, 2024, at 11:00 am at St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church, 3008 Old Raleigh Rd., Apex NC. The service will be followed by dual inurnment of the ashes of Ed and Charlene in the St. Andrew's columbarium, and a memorial luncheon at the parish center.
