



## Paula Ilene Rapuano

August 11, 1945 - March 31, 2026

Paula Ilene Rapuano (née Hayes), of Chapel Hill, North Carolina, passed away peacefully at her home in the early morning hours of Tuesday, March 31, 2026, surrounded by the love of her family. She was 80 years old.

Paula was born on August 11, 1945, in Oklahoma to William and Ora Hayes, the beloved middle child in a lively family of fourteen siblings. At just two months old, her family relocated to the Fresno, California area, where she spent her formative years and developed the warmth, resilience, and strong family values that would define her life.

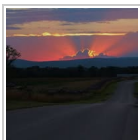
