Raised in Edmonton, Peng attended elementary schools, junior high and Harry Ainlay Senior High School in Edmonton where he graduated in 1989 with an International Baccalaureate Diploma as the school's valedictorian. He attended the University of Alberta and graduated in 1993 with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering. An outstanding student, he not only earned many awards and scholarships along the way, he also helped many of his fellow students in their studies.

He joined Cisco Systems in 2000, Videxio in 2014 and Pexip in 2018, where his work ethic and performance earned him the respect of his co-workers and customers everywhere.

Peng was an energetic and adventurous man who enjoyed people and travel. He was an endurance athlete who completed numerous marathons and triathlons worldwide and became an Ironman in 2008 in Wilmington, North Carolina.

One of Peng's favourite pastimes was being with his friends and enjoying a good meal. He loved life. Most of all, he loved his family and all his friends. Peng left the world much too soon. He will be greatly missed by all.

“ This is a message from Rhonda, Peng's mother, sent on November 2nd, 2008 to all who knew Peng as she was so proud of him.

"Hello Everyone:

Peng had just called to let us know that he had completed his goal to be an IRONMAN!

For the past 2 1/2 to 3 years, he had completed as many as 30 to 40 races, half marathons, marathons, biathlons and triathlons locally in North Carolina, out-of-town competitions in several US States, Victoria 2006 (with Michael) and even the Urkunde, the Berlin Marathon in October 2007, collecting medals and certificates along the way.

Early this year, he decided to train for the Ironman in Willminton, SC, on November 01, 2008. After a year of gruelling intense training with a swimming instructor and a gym trainer, regular checkups with his doctor and self-disciplined training sessions every day.....he did it today!! The ironman consists of:

- 2.4 mile swim,
- 112 mile biking, and
- 26.2 mile run

Maximum time allowed for the total race is 17 hours. Peng completed the course in 13 hours 40 minutes,
