



Quint Ronald Ocock

Quint Ronald Ocock, of Apex, NC, passed away at home peacefully surrounded by his wife and children on August 12, 2022, after a four-year battle with cancer. He leaves behind his wife of 30 years, Debra Blake Ocock; two daughters, Lindsey Ocock of Charleston, SC, and Gracie Ocock, of Waco, TX; and two sons, Wyatt Ocock and Carson Ocock, both of the home.

Quint was preceded in death by his parents, Roland Vance Ocock and Audrey Ann Ocock Maynard. He is also survived by his in-laws, Harold and Judith Blake, and brother-in-law Michael Blake; his brother, Craig Ocock (Erin) of Arizona; sisters Sheila Scott (Michael) of Wisconsin, Stephanie Koebele (Eric) of Illinois, and Selena Spring (Matt) of South Dakota along with many other loving friends and family.
