Ralph Joseph Juris, age 81, passed away at his home in Morrisville on Tuesday, November 10, 2015. He was born on August 30, 1934 in Minneapolis, Minnesota to Katherine (Schneider) and Paul Juris . Ralph began working for Edison Brothers Shoes in 1951 as a part time Sales and Stock Boy in Minneapolis, and retired from his position as Vice President for Edison Brothers Stores Incorporated with a golden handshake in 1986. He served as member of the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War, from 1953 to 1957, and was an active member of the American Legion, Post 67, in Cary, N.C.. Ralph married the love of his life, Mary Ann Aws, on May 20, 1957, and was married for 50 years. Together, Mary Ann and Ralph raised 5 children in Long Island, New York. In their years of retirement, Ralph and Mary Ann enjoyed traveling together, as well as spending time with their family and friends. Ralph enjoyed playing golf, bingo, cribbage and cards, and could be found most Saturday mornings, "saleing" through neighborhood yard sales to add to Biggie's Botique. Ralph had a kind spirit and a contagious smile. He was always willing to share a helping hand and a healing hug.
