Randolph “Randy” Bray Phelps (85) of Apex, N.C. passed away on January 2, 2020 due to cardiovascular and pulmonary related illnesses.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 5th, 2020 at Catawba Springs Christian Church in Apex, NC with Pastor Chuck Woodruff officiating. Visitation for family and friends will be held at the church prior to the service at 2:00 p.m. Burial will follow the funeral at the church cemetery. to their native home of N.C. He enjoyed every moment of living on the family farm where Beth grew up. During his spare time he enjoyed playing golf and spending time with his family and friends and his dog, Buddy.

Randy is survived by his wife of 45 years Beth Pierce Phelps. Together they had two children, Elizabeth (Curtis) and Jonathan. Randy is also survived by children from a previous marriage: sons David (Donna), Philip (Kim), daughter Melody (Joe), and daughter-in-law Lisa. Additionally, he is survived by grandchildren: Jon Curtis, Rachel, Hannah, Ansley, Kole, Cambry, Lyndsey, Haley, Tyler, Maggie, Kristie, Brittany, Melissa, in addition to eight great-grandchildren, and other family and friends. 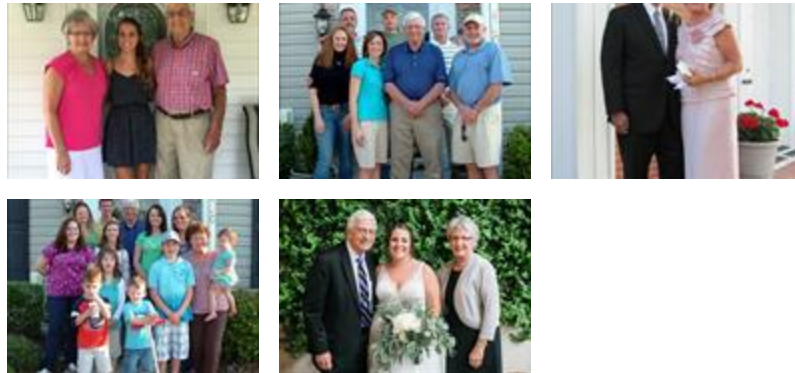
