Robert Exum Haas Jr., 89, of Cary, North Carolina, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, surrounded by his loving family.

Born on July 4, 1936, in Cleveland, Ohio, he was the beloved son of Robert Exum Haas Sr. and Betty Gabriel Haas.
