Robert E. “Bob” Waring, Jr., 72, died October 2, 2020. He was born in Vicksburg, MS, to Robert E. Waring, Sr. and Nell Hammond Waring. He attended the University of Mississippi where he was a member of Kappa Sigma fraternity, received a business degree in 1969, and soon after, married Ann, the mother of his daughter, Elizabeth. Bob spent his adult life in North Carolina, where, over the years, he lived in Greenville, Raleigh, Cary, Wake Forest, Wilmington, and Holly Springs. He built a successful property management business in Raleigh, from which he retired several years ago. He will be remembered for his business acumen, love of a good time, sense of humor, kindness and generosity. Bob never met a stranger, was a lifelong fan of basketball and the Dallas Cowboys, and took pleasure in passing down his love of golf to his grandchildren. 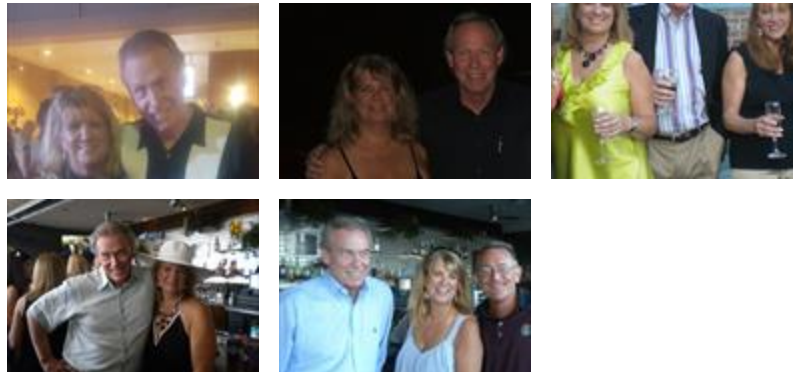
