Sang-Hoon Sin, 54, of Chapel Hill, North Carolina, passed away on Saturday, August 6, 2022. He was born in South Korea and received his Bachelor's and Master's at Seoul National University, before moving to North Carolina to earn his PhD at North Carolina State University. He then worked for seventeen years in the Dittmer Lab of the UNC School of Medicine and the Lineberger Comprehensive Cancer Center, first as a Research Scientist and eventually becoming an Assistant Research Professor.

Sang-Hoon was passionately dedicated to the scientific community and furthering societally beneficial research, in particular the study of Kaposi Sarcoma tumorigenesis. An avid lover of music, he enjoyed listening to music of all varieties (prog rock, Japanese enka, and alternative/folk being a few favorites). He quit smoking in 2008 and was an active member of the online Korean non-smoking community.

He is survived by his daughters, Soomin and Youngmin Shin, in the United States. Our father will be remembered for his thoughtfulness and sense of humor. We miss him dearly.
