As a family, they spent countless hours together, especially enjoying family vacations. Friends have described her as loyal, bubbly, funny and appreciated her unique brand of honesty of telling them if what they were wearing looked ok! She was always recognized for her kind and generous heart. She loved being able to participate in service projects and activities at both school and church. She lived her life as an example of service, helpfulness and usefulness in everything she dedicated herself to.

Skyler attended GRACE Christian School as an eighth grader. She was a cheerleader and volleyball player for the school. As a member of the GRACE vocal ensemble, she was known for her beautiful voice in the choir. One teacher has described her as "always doing exactly what she was supposed to be doing and a very mature student." Skyler was diligent and excelled academically. She was a leader and an example to her fellow classmates.
