Stanley “Stan” Carson McDaniel passed away unexpectedly at his home on Wednesday, July 3, 2019. Stan was born on October 22, 1963 in Cincinnati, Ohio to Janice Mahall McDaniel and Felix Carson McDaniel.

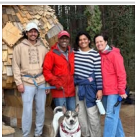
