Toni Pappas Brandt passed away on November 21, 2016. She was born on January 17, 1965 in Lubbock, TX to Constantine Anthony Pappas and Elizabeth Clikas Pappas.

Toni grew up in Montgomery, Alabama graduating from Jefferson Davis High School in 1983 and from Auburn University in 1987. Out of college Toni worked for the Alabama Shakespeare Festival and later moved to Atlanta, GA and worked as an International Operations Manager for the Monarch Beverage Company. After her marriage in 1998 Toni lived in Ireland and California before moving to Cary, North Carolina where she raised her family and resided up until her passing.

Toni is preceded in death by her father Constantine (Dean) Pappas and her sister Christine Trotman. She is survived by her husband, Robert Brandt, children Grace Kathryn, and Robert Max of Cary, NC; mother Elizabeth Pappas of Dunwoody, GA, brother, Dean Pappas of Woodstock, GA; nieces Ellen Trotman Ashmore (Ramsey) of Montgomery, AL, Tyler McNeil Trotman of Stephenville, TX, Arianna Pappas of Woodstock, GA.

She sang like Stevie Nicks and it was moving. We would have " make-over day" and she would curl my hair and do make-up (fun girl stuff). Toni was the friend everyone wanted to have. That was 1978. Toni had a gift of humor and warmth that made anyone in her presence feel special. She was a giver. Her wit and charm has stayed with me. 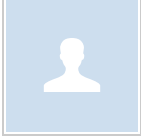
