Then we thought we could have our own “squad”, the three of us, with our bear nicknames. So I made up these hats for each of us and we called ourselves #BearSquad.

When I brought Tony the Tony Bear hat he gave me a present too, a puzzle. Tony also wrote me a card that I still have, he wrote:

Sometimes I would wake up in the middle of the night and Tony would be awake too. I would text him and ask if he wanted to play Fun Run. In the game we both had a bear character, mine was just a normal bear but Tony's was decked out in gold and jewelry and all types of cool stuff.

Every time someone else joined with an awesome bear costume on we would get so excited. I'll miss playing video games with Tony in the middle of the night. Tony told me that at the hospital he could go down the hallway and play video games whenever he wanted and this sounded really cool.

One day Tony's mom took us to Dave and Busters together and we were playing that game with the giant claw, where you try and pick something up. We really wanted this giant gecko plushy but so did this man who was there. He told us that he had been trying to get it for six months. Tony and I really wanted it too because it looked awesome! We finally got it after our fifth try and working on the perfect angle to be able to grab it. We also got an M&M plushy that I got for Tony and Tony let me have the gecko.

We were going to go over to the guy to tell him that we got the gecko but after we looked at the guy we laughed and realized he probably wouldn't be too happy about it.

After that Tony spun the big wheel that you get tickets on and he got a thousand tickets twice! It was a really fun day and I'm so glad that Tony asked me to spend it with him.

I remember planning out a party with Tony for when he was going to get better. We were thinking about either a giant soccer game and inviting everyone to play or going to Jelly Beans which is a roller skating place. I know Tony will be playing soccer and roller skating up in heaven and when I play soccer I will be playing for Tony
