Veronica Anne Grover Bucki, born March 23, 1941 passed away March 24, 2021. She was born in Warsaw, New York to the late Floyd Grover and Agnes (Bartz) Grover. Veronica is survived by her beloved husband of sixty years, Pete, and her four adoring children Deanna of Portland, Oregon; Denise (Kevin) of Lambton, New South Wales, Australia; Chris (Susan) of Charlotte, North Carolina, and Susan (Jeff) of Houston, Texas. Veronica had many diverse employment opportunities, including working at IBM for ten years, for the Town of Cary for eight years and various other roles.
