Vito was born on September 25, 1940, in Syracuse to Vito and Harriet Romano. He graduated from Syracuse University in 1962 with a degree in accountancy, and worked for IBM in Finance for more than 30 years. Vito also served in the U.S. Army National Guard as a staff sergeant. An avid golfer, Vito worked at a local golf course in Poughkeepsie, NY, upon retirement before he moved to Cary in 2006. Since moving to Cary, Vito volunteered with his neighborhood and with St. Michael the Archangel Catholic Church, where he was a parishioner; he also loved traveling and visiting his children and grandchildren.

Vito was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife Nancy, of 55 years; his brother Ronald Romano; his children Vito Romano (Linda), Terri Kristopeit (Ben), and Michael Romano (Audra); and his grandchildren Jennifer Romano, Melissa Romano, Annie Kristopeit, and Joe Kristopeit.
