William Victor Fierke died peacefully at Brittany Skilled Nursing facility on November 9, 2024. We are thankful for the wonderful care provided to him by the staff at Brittany. Bill was preceded in death by his parents, Victor and Eleanore, his brother Donald, and his sisters Betty, Carol, Doris and Marilyn. He is survived by his wife Nancy, daughter Laura (Throop, PA), son Eric, and son-in-law Fen (Brown Summit, NC).

Bill grew up in Central Wisconsin and was forever a Green Bay Packers and Wisconsin Badgers fan. He joined the Coast Guard after high school and served 5 years. He was discharged in Washington D.C. where he began his career in information technology. It was there that he met his wife, Nancy. They were married in 1969 and would have celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary on November 22.

Nancy and Bill were well-loved members of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Cary from the time they moved to NC in 1978. Bill was a central figure, quietly serving the parish in innumerable roles over the years. But he was probably most known for his ability to gather the congregation over a good meal, coordinating the food preparation for multiple annual church events, fundraising efforts and special occasions.
