Wilma Johnson Honeycutt was welcomed into the arms of Jesus on May 15, 2019 after several years of decline due to dementia.

Wilma was born and raised in Chatham County, NC. She married the love of her life, Johnny V. Johnson, on October 27, 1956. They were blessed with three children. Wilma was a community volunteer serving as a Brownie leader and serving in both the Apex Firebelles Auxiliary and the Apex Rescue Squad. She served with the squad for many years and continued even after the death of Johnny in November 1989.

She was an avid NASCAR and local racing fan, attending many events at the local speedways. Wilma was blessed to fall in love again and married Wallace Honeycutt on October 11, 1997.
